## ACADEMIC REGALIA

The wearing of academic costume is a tradition that has persisted from the Middle Ages, when the first Universities were founded.

The regalia vary slightly from one University to another and, within a University, according to the status of the wearer.

At The University of British Columbia the undergraduate's gown is black and of the ordinary stuff material; the yoke is edged with khaki cord. The Master's gown is similar but lacks the cord.

The colours for the degrees are:

B.A.—University blue

B.F.A.—University blue with magenta cord

B.A.Sc.—Scarlet

B.COM.—Light grey with black and grey cord

LIC. ACCT.—Light grey with white cord

B.ED.—White with cord of University blue

B.H.E.—Turquoise

B.L.A.—Maize with scarlet cord

M.L.S.—Cadmium yellow

M.A.S.—University blue with silver and cadmium yellow twisted cord

B.MUS.—University blue with cord of alizarin crimson

B.Sc.—Light blue

B.ARCH.—Scarlet with white cord

D.M.D.—Lilac and red

ED.D.—Blue and gold with blue, white and yellow chevrons

B.P.E.—Malachite green

B.R.E.—Malachite green with gold and green cord

B.Sc.(AGR.)—Maize

B.Sc.(DIETET.)—Turquoise with gold and white twisted cord

B.S.F.—Brown with green cord

B.Sc.(FORESTRY)—Brown with blue cord

B.S.N.—Scarlet with twisted cord of University blue and white

B.Sc.(PHARM.)—Dark green with scarlet cord

B.Sc.(O.T.)—Scarlet and white twisted cord on royal blue

B.Sc.(P.T.)—Scarlet and white twisted cord on royal blue

B.S.W.—Magenta

LL.B.—Amethyst violet

M.D.—Scarlet and royal blue

B.M.L.Sc.—White with a twisted cord of scarlet and royal blue

M.H.Sc.—Scarlet and grey

PH.D.—Blue and gold

D.M.A.—Royal blue and alizarin crimson with blue and gold chevron

The Bachelor's hood is edged with the distinctive colour. The Master's hood is the same as the Bachelor's, except that it is lined with the distinctive colour. The hood for the M.Sc. (Bus. Admin.) is similar to that of the M.Sc., with grey trim and black and white cord. The hood for the M.Eng. is similar to that of the M.A.Sc., except that it is trimmed with a cord of University blue.

The regalia of the Ph.D. consists of a gown, Cambridge style, of maroon silk with front facing-panel and sleeves of University blue with gold piping; a hood, Cambridge pattern, of blue silk outside and gold lining; a cap, decanal bonnet, of maroon silk with gold cord and tassel. The regalia of the Ed.D. consist of a gown of similar style but of black stuff, a hood, American style, black with front facing of University blue velvet, fully lined sky blue, with chevron of University blue, white and yellow; a cap, decanal bonnet of black stuff with gold cord and tassel. The hood for the honorary degree LL.D. is of scarlet broadcloth lined with dark blue velvet. For the D.Sc. it is lined in dark purple. For the D.Litt. it is lined in cream.

## 1991 UNIVERSITY TEACHING PRIZE WINNERS

### Faculty of Agricultural Sciences

Brenton J. Skura Associate Professor, Department of Food Sciences

An internationally recognized food microbiologist, Dr. Skura researches microbial invasion and spoilage of food, and appropriate strategies to overcome these undesirable processes. His mastery at teaching these and other important food science principles is attested to by the consistently high ratings given to him by all students taking his courses.

### Faculty of Applied Science

Clarissa Green Associate Professor, School of Nursing

Professor Green is recognized by students, colleagues and alumni as an outstanding teacher. Her expertise is in the area of family nursing, particularly the effects of stress on working women, and on the relationship between midlife daughters and their aging parents. She is well known for her innovative teaching methods, particularly in small group seminars, and for her effectiveness in addressing the needs of mature learners.

Desmond Tromans Professor, Department of Metals & Materials Engineering

Professor Tromans is an innovative, conscientious and involved teacher. He has developed undergraduate and graduate courses in his area of specialization—the corrosion of both metallic and non-metallic materials—that are fundamental to the design and materials selection capabilities of his students. His excellent teaching is attested to not only by his students, but also by colleagues in the university and in the pulp and paper industry, where he is a recognized expert on corrosion.

### Faculty of Arts

Sue Ann Alderson Associate Professor, Department of Creative Writing

For a decade, Professor Alderson's skill as a writer and teacher has nurtured at UBC the first Writing of Children's Literature programme in Canada. Her method is to thrill readers and students into learning from literary adventures. An instructor who uses delight to instruct, she is a model of excellence in teaching.

Heath Chamberlain Assistant Professor, Department of Political Science

Professor Chamberlain is noted for his carefully crafted lectures, for his ability to transmit his enthusiasm and interest in Chinese politics to students, for keeping abreast of the dramatic changes occurring in that country and in its relations with its neighbours, and for his close interaction with students in their research projects.

Alexander Globe Professor, Department of English

Dr. Globe has successfully combined his interests in biblical tradition and Renaissance literature to develop new approaches to the teaching of mythic and typological elements in literary forms. He has taken his unabashed enthusiasm for learning into the classroom; and he has provided students with an admirable model of the teacher-scholar for whom literature is a vital and enduring record of human experience.

Katherine Sirluck Assistant Professor, Department of English

Katherine Sirluck is held in the highest esteem by her students, as much for her compassion and concern for their welfare as for the driving power and extraordinary insight she brings to the study of Renaissance literature. She combines the freshness and vigour of contemporary feminist criticism with an unswerving commitment to openness and integrity in the classroom; and in the process, she provides students with a truly inspiring model of academic excellence.

James Winter Professor, Department of History

Since joining the department in 1961, Jim Winter has always sought new ways to teach, interest and excite students. Above all, he consistently takes a close personal interest in his students, acting as their best advisor. He is an enthusiastic teacher and an excellent example of a devoted university instructor.

### Faculty of Commerce and Business Administration

Charles Weinberg Alumni Professor of Marketing

Besides being an excellent teacher in the classroom over many years, Dr. Weinberg has written a popular casebook and has developed a set of computerized marketing cases, extensively used at UBC and elsewhere. He has also been instrumental in the development of the very successful courses in Public and Non-Profit Marketing.

Steve Alisharan Lecturer

Mr. Alisharan has achieved high teaching ratings for many years, over an astonishing number of sections. His versatility in terms of the different courses taught and the fact that many of the courses are difficult to teach (e.g. auditing, taxation) contributed to this award. He previously won the CUS Teaching Award and in the last two years has exceptional performance in SIR ratings. Finally, we acknowledge his contribution to the Undergraduate Programme as Director in the mid-1980s.

### Faculty of Dentistry

Marcia Boyd Associate Professor, Department of Clinical Dental Sciences

Dr. Boyd is a dedicated teacher who has established an international reputation for innovative approaches to instruction in the oral health sciences. Students and peers characterize her as an effective and understanding teacher who combines high standards of expectation, a solid grasp of her discipline and a caring concern for the educational needs of her students.

### Faculty of Education

Walter Werner Associate Professor, Department of Social and Educational Studies

Dr. Werner is an outstanding teacher and supervisor. Graduate students in the Curriculum Centre find him intellectually exciting, available and supportive and this is reflected in the quality of their work. His knowledge of the field, sensitivity to developing issues and energy have contributed to the development of curriculum studies in the faculty and the province.

Inge Williams Assistant Professor, School of Physical Education

Dr. Williams has been recognized consistently by her students as an outstanding teacher. Her impact in Multicultural Education, Community Education, NITEP, the practicum and her concern for the role of women is as significant as her classroom teaching. Dr. Williams' leadership, reputation and ability to bring groups together to their mutual benefit is widely acknowledged.

### Faculty of Forestry

Timothy M. Ballard Professor, Department of Forest Resources Management

Dr. Ballard is well recognized by undergraduates, graduates and colleagues as an effective and dedicated teacher. He is extremely well organized, logical and articulate. He has the ability to mix humour with academic rigor, without compromising either one. Even with his busy schedule he has an open-door policy and makes himself available to students. His advice is sought not only by students in his formal classes but by others who seek him out because of his reputation.

### Faculty of Graduate Studies

Catharine Rankin Assistant Professor, Department of Psychology

Peter Reiner Assistant Professor, Department of Psychiatry

Drs. Rankin and Reiner share the award this year. These two young faculty members have made outstanding contributions to the interdisciplinary graduate Neuroscience programme. Both have received excellent ratings from their students in course evaluations. They have developed and coordinated new courses that have been so successful that a considerable number of students from outside the programme have enrolled. They have also organized a series of informal seminars, discussion groups and retreats that have served to bring together a community of scholars from a variety of disciplines, enriching the educational environment for studies in Neuroscience.

## Faculty of Law

Barry Slutsky Associate Professor

Barry Slutsky has been teaching at UBC since 1969. An outstanding teacher, Dr. Slutsky was nominated for the Faculty of Law Teaching Excellence Award in three out of four years of its existence before being declared the winner in 1990/91. He specializes in the fields of Corporate Law and Torts.

## Faculty of Medicine

Victor Huckell Clinical Associate Professor, Division of Cardiology

Dr. Huckell is an outstanding clinician-educator. His excellence as a teacher has had a major impact on all levels of training, from the undergraduate medical student to the practising physician. His greatest impact is in the area of the recognition of important clinical findings and translations of these findings into the understanding of disease. Through his leadership, a number of innovative programmes have been developed and have clearly had a major influence on the teaching of cardiology; central to these innovations was Dr. Huckell's enthusiasm and excellence as a teacher.

Michael Myers Clinical Professor, Department of Psychiatry

Dr. Myers has attained international recognition in his field, in large part due to his excellence as a teacher. His teaching skills are enhanced by an extremely humane concern for the welfare of his patients, colleagues and, in particular, students. Teaching has always been given the highest priority in Dr. Myers' career. His excellence as a teacher has enriched students at all levels and his knowledge, dedication and teaching skills have had an impact on society beyond the university.

Joanne Wright Professor, Department of Pathology

Dr. Wright embodies all of the qualities which define a true "teacher-scientist". She combines an excellent and productive research career with an equally outstanding contribution in the area of teaching. Her teaching skills have had a major impact on the education of undergraduate and graduate students in this Faculty and her true caring for students at all levels has further enhanced her excellence as a teacher. The university is proud to have Dr. Wright on its faculty.

## Faculty of Pharmaceutical Sciences

Jack Diamond Professor & Chairman, Pharmacology & Toxicology

Dr. Diamond won teaching prizes at Northwestern University Medical School before coming to UBC. Since his arrival he has been selected twice by the graduating class as Teacher of the Year (1982, 1991) and was awarded the Bristol Myers Squibb Teaching Award for Excellence in Teaching in 1987. At any alumni meeting, at least one person will inquire about Dr. Diamond and then comment, "He was the best teacher that I ever had."

## Faculty of Science

Nicholas Burlinson Lecturer, Department of Chemistry

Dr. Burlinson teaches inorganic and physical chemistry chiefly for Life Science students; material which initially seems far from these students' interests, but with his enthusiastic presentation, the course comes alive. Lectures are clear and evenly paced, yet relaxed. No suitable textbook exists for the course, so he prepares superb, updated notes for the students. He has also taught successful graduate courses in nuclear magnetic resonance.

Malcolm McMillan Professor, Department of Physics

Dr. McMillan has been one of the best teachers in this Faculty for nearly three decades, teaching 21 different courses, from first-year undergraduate physics and mathematics to graduate courses in nuclear and particle physics. He is clear, stimulating and responsive to students' needs, and his presentations range from meticulously prepared overhead slides and concise handout sheets for a first-year course to notes which serve as a text tailored to a graduate course.

Francis Tufaro Assistant Professor, Department of Microbiology

Dr. Tufaro has been at UBC for only four years, but his teaching has had a major impact in animal virology, where the completely reorganized course has doubled in enrollment. He is enthusiastic and committed to his students understanding concepts of cell-virus interaction. He updates and revises course material by adding modern, relevant developments in virology. Novel teaching methods stimulate discussion in the large class, and a flexible grading scheme permits students to demonstrate their knowledge to their best advantage.
