ACADEMIC REGALIA

The wearing of academic costume is a tradition that has persisted from the Middle Ages, when the first Universities were founded.

The regalia vary slightly from one University to another and, within a University, according to the status of the wearer.

At The University of British Columbia the undergraduate's gown is black and of the ordinary stuff material; the yoke is edged with khaki cord. The Master's gown is similar but lacks the cord.

The Bachelor's hood is edged with the distinctive colour. The Master's hood is the same as the Bachelor's, except that it is lined with the distinctive colour. The hood for the M.Sc. (Bus. Admin.) is similar to that of the M.Sc., with grey trim and black and white cord. The hood for the M.Eng. is the same as that of the M.A.Sc., except that it is trimmed with a cord of University blue.

The regalia of the Ph.D. consists of a gown, Cambridge style, of maroon silk with front facing-panel and sleeves of University blue with gold piping; a hood, Cambridge pattern, of blue silk outside and gold lining; a cap, decanal bonnet, of maroon silk with gold cord and tassel. The Ed.D. regalia consists of a gown similar in style to that of the Ph.D. but of black stuff; hood American style with lining of light blue and with chevron of University blue, white and gold; cap, decanal bonnet of black stuff with gold cord and tassel. The hood for the honorary degree LL.D. is of scarlet broadcloth lined with dark blue velvet. For the D.Sc. it is lined in dark purple. For the D.Litt. it is lined in cream.

1992 UNIVERSITY TEACHING PRIZE WINNERS

Faculty of Agricultural Sciences

No award to be presented this year.

Faculty of Applied Science

Robert L. Evans Professor, Department of Mechanical Engineering

Professor Robert Evans has made excellent contributions to teaching, research, and professional activities at UBC. His teaching has been consistently excellent, and he is highly respected and well liked by his students. Dr. Evans was instrumental in introducing the use of micro-computers in the fourth year power generation course in Mechanical Engineering. He has acted as the Society of Automotive Engineers Faculty Advisor for ten years, and has been actively involved in supervising a number of student groups entered in design competitions, including the Natural Gas Vehicle Challenge, and the Formula SAE Competition sponsored by the Society of Automotive Engineers. Dr. Evans' research concerns the combustion process in internal combustion engines, cogeneration and combined cycle power generation, and with the fundamental fluid mechanics of turbomachinery. His research is primarily aimed at improving energy efficiency and reducing exhaust emissions. Dr. Evans holds two US patents for engine combustion chamber design. Both students and colleagues know him as a warm and compassionate person, and enjoy interacting with him.

Wendy Hall Assistant Professor, School of Nursing

Professor Wendy Hall is recognized by colleagues and students as a faculty member who sets high standards and challenges students to perform at their maximum, while providing a supportive and sensitive learning environment. She maintains her skills as a nurse clinician expert in the care of families with newborn infants, thereby enhancing the quality of educational experiences for students. As an active researcher, she effectively incorporates in her teaching relevant research findings from her own work as well as the work of others. Professor Hall also provides outstanding leadership in working with new and inexperienced faculty, assisting them to gain confidence in their teaching ability and to develop their own unique style. A former student aptly describes Professor Hall's qualifications for this award as follows: "She starts with warmth, empathy and respect for students as adults and individuals. She creates a positive non-judgmental environment for growth. Her enthusiasm for nursing is evident in her dedication to her job and the way she teaches. She uses variety and humour to keep the education process fresh and interesting, and involves students in that process in a very active way." Professor Wendy Hall is a highly respected, multitalented, and totally committed university educator, scholar, and nurse clinician, a most worthy recipient of the Applied Science Teaching Prize.

Faculty of Arts

David Donaldson Professor, Department of Economics

David Donaldson specializes in social choice theory, welfare economics and public finance. Since joining UBC in 1964 he has taught a variety of courses, ranging from introductory economics and Arts One to advanced graduate courses. He is highly regarded as an enthusiastic and stimulating teacher and supervisor. Current and past students particularly stress his ability to make highly abstract material understandable and accessible, his ability to maintain students' focus on the social significance of the issues being addressed, and his deep interest in students' well being in addition to their understanding.

Marketa Goetz-Stankiewicz Professor, Department of Germanic Studies

Dr. Goetz-Stankiewicz is respected by students and colleagues in Germanic Studies and Comparative Literature as a truly outstanding teacher. She has brought an absolutely up-to-date knowledge of modern German and Czech literature to her classes. Through her dedication and enthusiasm and through her "open" style of teaching she has enriched the lives of her students by encouraging them to develop their own ideas creatively and critically.

Neil Guppy Associate Professor, Department of Anthropology and Sociology
Professor Guppy links theoretical sociology to the practical. He regularly assists students in planning and achieving their career goals, both inside and outside the university. His popularity and impact extend beyond the Faculty of Arts to the Faculties of Applied Science and Forestry.

John Roeder Associate Professor, School of Music
Dr. Roeder's research specialties are diverse, including theories of contemporary art music, rhythm, and applications of semiotics, mathematics, and artificial intelligence. His work has attracted support from SSHRC and other nationally-recognized agencies, and his publications span the major journals in his field. He is equally at home teaching undergraduates and graduates, and his teaching combines intellectual rigor with compassion for his students. That compassion extends beyond his job description; he has taught Sunday School for the past six years, and has served as the Scoutmaster of the Richmond 13th Troop.

Mary Sue Stephenson Assistant Professor, School of Library, Archival and Information Studies
Since joining the school in 1987, Dr. Stephenson's commitment to her students has been exceptional. She is held in great esteem by students and her colleagues for her endless patience and sincere concern for her students, as well as for her humourously incisive teaching style. An experienced professional information specialist who is active in professional organizations, she daily demonstrates her mastery of the complexities of the design, construction and application of computer systems for information handling, yet always has time to offer friendly counsel to students and faculty alike.

Faculty of Commerce and Business Administration

Peter Frost Edgar F. Kaiser, Jr. Professor of Industrial Relations
Peter Frost's award is for significant pedagogical innovation in methods of management education. Professor Frost was nominated for his innovative development of a text in *Organizational Behaviour, Management Live*. A significant aspect of this book is its full integration with video materials. A number of courses and even texts make use of video materials, but none so far has actually been constructed to fully integrate the video material into the pedagogical development of course materials. The adoption of Dr. Frost's innovation by management schools outside of UBC is powerful evidence of the importance of his contribution.

Rob Heinkel A.E. Hall Professor of Finance
Professor Heinkel has a sustained record of teaching excellence in undergraduate finance courses. He has played a major role in the development of the Portfolio Management Society. The Society is an important element of the education of Finance majors, including those who do not participate directly. This program, in which students manage a \$1 million portfolio, requires significant amounts of time, both for student interaction and for interaction with the downtown business community.

Sloan Fellowship, a UBC Killam Research Prize and a Canada Council Killam Research Fellowship; he is a fellow of the Royal Society of Canada.

Wilfred B. Schofield

Professor, Department of Botany

Dr. Wilfred Schofield has made major contributions to the teaching of Botany at U.B.C. for over three decades. These range from a very heavy course teaching load (four courses in 1991-92), and an exceptional commitment to laboratory education, to the writing of a textbook on Bryology which has won several awards, and preparation of detailed course notes for a course on Phytogeography when there was no available text. His dedication to laboratory education is such that he spends most weekends collecting materials for the labs, and, where necessary, modifying the lab manual write-up to accommodate the available material. Dr. Schofield is well recognized as an approachable and concerned teacher, very sensitive to the needs of students; this is reflected in very high student ratings of his teaching. Dr. Schofield has also had a productive research career, with over 60 research publications, and has collaborated on five standard textbooks on botany.
