ACADEMIC REGALIA

The wearing of academic costume is a tradition that has persisted from the Middle Ages, when the first Universities were founded.

The regalia vary slightly from one University to another and, within a University, according to the status of the wearer.

At The University of British Columbia the undergraduate's gown is black and of the ordinary stuff material; the yoke is edged with khaki cord. The Master's gown is similar but lacks the cord.

The colours for the degrees are:

B.A.—University blue

B.F.A.—University blue with magenta cord

B.A.Sc.—Scarlet

B.COM.—Light grey with black and grey cord

B.ED.—White with cord of University blue

B.H.E.—Turquoise

B.L.A.—Maize with scarlet cord

M.L.S.—Cadmium yellow

M.A.S.—University blue with silver and cadmium yellow twisted cord

B.Mus.—University blue with cord of alizarin crimson

B.Sc.—Light blue

B.ARCH.—Scarlet with white cord

B.D.Sc.—Lilac and red with twisted cord on white

D.M.D.—Lilac and red

ED.D.—Royal blue and light blue, with blue, white and gold chevrons

B.P.E.—Malachite green

B.R.E.—Malachite green with gold and green cord

B.Sc.(AGR.)—Maize

B.Sc.(DIETET.)—Turquoise with gold and white twisted cord

B.S.F.—Brown with green cord

B.Sc.(FORESTRY)—Brown with light blue cord

B.S.N.—Scarlet with twisted cord of University blue and white

B.Sc.(PHARM.)—Dark green with scarlet cord

B.Sc.(O.T.)—Scarlet and white twisted cord on royal blue

B.Sc.(P.T.)—Scarlet and white twisted cord on royal blue

B.S.W.—Magenta

LL.B.—Amethyst violet

M.D.—Scarlet and royal blue

B.M.L.Sc.—Scarlet and royal blue twisted cord on white

M.H.A.—Red and pale blue

M.A. (PLANNING)—University blue with dark green and slate grey

M.Sc.(PLANNING)—University blue with dark green and white

M.H.Sc.—Scarlet and grey

PH.D.—Blue and gold

D.M.A.—Royal blue and alizarin crimson with blue and gold chevron

Pharm.D.—American style with lining of University blue and with chevron of University blue and gold

The Bachelor's hood is edged with the distinctive colour. The Master's hood is the same as the Bachelor's, except that it is lined with the distinctive colour. The hood for the M.Sc. (Bus. Admin.) is similar to that of the M.Sc., with grey trim and black and white cord. The hood for the M.Eng. is the same as that of the M.A.Sc., except that it is trimmed with a cord of University blue.

The regalia of the Ph.D. consists of a gown, Cambridge style, of maroon silk with front facing-panel and sleeves of University blue with gold piping; a hood, Cambridge pattern, of blue silk outside and gold lining; a cap, decanal bonnet, of maroon silk with gold cord and tassel. The Ed.D. regalia consists of a gown, Cambridge style, of black stuff; a hood, American style, with lining of light blue and with chevron of University blue, white and gold; a cap, decanal bonnet, of black stuff with gold cord and tassel. The Pharm.D. regalia consists of a gown, Cambridge style, of black stuff with front facing panel and sleeves of dark olive green with gold piping; a hood, American style, with lining of University blue and with chevron of University blue and gold; a cap, decanal bonnet, of black stuff with gold cord and tassel.

The hood for the honorary degree LL.D. is of scarlet broadcloth lined in dark blue velvet; for the D.Sc., it is lined in dark purple and for the D. Litt., it is lined in cream.

1994 UNIVERSITY TEACHING PRIZE WINNERS

Faculty of Agricultural Sciences

Les Lavkulich

Professor, Department of Soil Science

Les Lavkulich enjoys an extended, enviable record of superior teaching evaluations in a wide variety of undergraduate and graduate courses. He is an unusually effective teacher, who has profoundly influenced the education of scientists and resource management professionals throughout his career at UBC. His depth and breadth of knowledge, his ability to provide clear explanations and his facility to place facts, theories and conjecture into perspective have earned him the reputation as a visionary who stimulates students to think for themselves. As a lecturer, teacher and communicator, Dr. Lavkulich is enthusiastic, witty, dynamic and always thoroughly-prepared. The Faculty of Agricultural Sciences is proud and pleased to recognize Dr. Lavkulich's contributions with its 1994 Teaching Award of Excellence.

Faculty of Applied Science

Clive M.H. Brereton

Associate Professor, Department of Chemical Engineering

Enthusiasm for teaching and interaction and rapport with students have been the hallmarks of Professor Brereton's approach to education since his first appointment as Assistant Professor in the Department of Chemical Engineering in 1987. From the beginning the students have welcomed his ability to explain difficult concepts clearly. It was the 1989 Third Year Chemical Engineering class that wrote an unsolicited letter to the Department Head asking that Professor Brereton be assigned, in the following year, "as many fourth year courses as possible"! Although this might not have been a form of recognition to be welcomed, the award of one of the 1994 Faculty of Applied Science Teaching Prizes is an appropriate, and well deserved reward for Professor Brereton's dedication to teaching.

Linda Leonard

Associate Professor, School of Nursing

Linda Leonard is an outstanding teacher in the School of Nursing. She specializes in community health nursing and in the nursing care associated with multiple pregnancies. In addition to her teaching on campus, Professor Leonard is a highly skilled clinical instructor, who creates learning opportunities for students in community health projects through her well-developed network of colleagues and her vision of health promotion and healthy communities. She has developed valuable course materials and teaching aids for use by her students, as well as by the nursing profession. Professor Leonard's expertise is used by Twin and Triplet Groups throughout the lower mainland to assist families with the challenging transition to parenting multiple infants. Professor Leonard's teaching ability has enabled her to assist new faculty members in the School on an individual basis, in order to help them develop their instructional skills. In recognition of her outstanding contribution to teaching and clinical education in the School of Nursing, Professor Leonard is awarded the 1994 Faculty of Applied Science Teaching Prize.

Faculty of Arts

Lynn Alden

Professor, Department of Psychology

Lynn Alden joined UBC in 1975 and since that time she has maintained an outstanding teaching and research record, acted as a consultant to a variety of local and national bodies and has been an editor and reviewer for many national and international journals. Her teaching evaluations, both qualitative and quantitative, have been consistently outstanding. She was awarded the Robert E. Knox Teaching Award for outstanding teaching in the Psychology Department in 1992. Undergraduate and graduate students provide written nominations for this award and a committee of faculty and students select the winner. She has published over 40 research articles, chapters and reviews. In addition, she has presented over 60 papers at national and international conferences.

Thomas Blom

Associate Professor, Department of English

Tom Blom has been one of the most popular instructors in the English Department for the last 30 years. His popularity springs from his recognition that education is not merely a matter of filling empty vessels, that students will gain most out of the experience of learning if they are given a part to play in the process, and share responsibility with their instructor. Tom Blom teaches his students how to work collaboratively towards a common goal. Under his leadership they take a major role in the conduct and evaluation of their courses, develop their speaking as well as their writing skills, and assume much of the responsibility for their own intellectual development. By declining to spoonfeed his students, Tom Blom teaches them to think independently and to approach learning as an exciting and empowering experience.

Paul Burns

Instructor, Department of Religious Studies

Paul Burns has been a lecturer at UBC since 1978 and an Instructor in the Department of Religious Studies since 1991. He has repeatedly shown himself to be an excellent teacher at all levels from first-year to graduate, and in every conceivable format from large lectures to small tutorials. What makes Dr. Burns truly extraordinary, however, is the incredible range of his teaching over the past 16 years: Religious Studies, Arts One, Classics (languages, literature and philosophy), English, History, Education and Biomedical Ethics! He claims that he owes his range and enthusiasm not only to his graduate and post-graduate training at Toronto and Oxford, but also to his work with the Basilian Fathers at Toronto and St. Mark's College, and especially to his family, nine of whom have been teachers.

Susanna Egan

Assistant Professor, Department of English

Since her first appointment less than four years ago, Susanna Egan has established herself as the kind of teacher whose students regard her as a model and an inspiration. From first year to graduate level, she conducts her classes as joint explorations in discovery, creating a stimulating but non-confrontational atmosphere in which students are encouraged to develop their ideas through open exchanges. She has an extraordinary ability to draw out other people's ideas, and to reconcile apparently opposing viewpoints. In all her classes Dr. Egan stresses cooperation, not competition; the result is that students feel that they are active participants in the process of learning. One of her graduate students sees her approach as an expression of her essential feminism, "a feminism concerned that no one feel intimidated, rebuked or silenced in her class". Dr. Egan has also been instrumental in establishing the Nineteenth Century Studies Group, an interdisciplinary body of faculty and students that meets to discuss a variety of topics presented by members of different departments in the Faculty of Arts. Here again she has embraced the ideal of a partnership of learning, and drawn her students into the kind of joint enterprise that university education at its best can provide.

Alan Tully

Associate Professor, Department of History

Alan Tully is a specialist in American colonial and revolutionary history with broad interests in the history of American politics and the origins of American political society. He came to UBC in 1972 and since then has been involved extensively in both undergraduate and graduate teaching. Dr. Tully's most important contributions to teaching have been his senior undergraduate lecture course - American Colonial and Revolutionary History, and his sustained commitment to our graduate program. Because Dr. Tully is an excellent teacher his lecture course has acted as a magnet for ambitious history majors, as well as thoughtful students from other specialties. Through his ongoing activities in the graduate program, Dr. Tully has made an outstanding contribution to the intellectual development of graduate students; they have all benefited greatly from his care and direction.

Faculty of Commerce and Business Administration

Tom Knight Associate Professor, Industrial Relations Management Division

Tom Knight is the 1993-94 recipient of the *Commerce Alumni Talking Stick Award* for developing the Internship Program for IRM option undergraduates in collaboration with the BC Human Resources Management Association. The program provides students with professional experience and exposure as well as the opportunity to conduct independent research under the supervision of an individual IRM faculty member. In six years, the Internship Program has placed almost 50 students with over 25 individual sponsors. The program has generated many benefits for students, sponsors and the Faculty. The Internship Program recently received a National Award for Excellence in Business-Education Partnerships from the Conference Board of Canada. The network created through the Internship Program was also instrumental in the establishment of the Centre for Labour and Management Studies in the Faculty of Commerce.

Craig C. Pinder Professor, Industrial Relations Management Division

Craig Pinder is the recipient of the Faculty of Commerce *CGA Master Teacher Award* for a career of consistently superior course development, classroom instruction and work with graduate students outside the classroom. Professor Pinder has provided some of the most intellectually demanding and provocative classroom experiences available to graduate students in Commerce and is able to create the completely supportive and ethical environment necessary for such a demanding experience to translate into genuine intellectual and personal growth. The award also recognizes the outstanding work Professor Pinder has done for many years with both MSc and PhD students and the inspiration to excel at research he has selflessly offered these students.

Faculty of Education

Patricia Arlin Professor, Department of Educational Psychology and Special Education

Pat Arlin is an excellent teacher whose teaching at both the undergraduate and graduate levels during her many years in the Faculty has earned her a reputation for enthusiasm, dedication and innovation among students and colleagues alike. Her work in the classroom and in course development is outstanding. Her scholarship in the area of cognitive development is internationally recognized and she is a much sought after speaker. Dr. Arlin's dedication to the personal and professional development of her graduate students is well known.

Kit Grauer Senior Instructor, Department of Visual and Performing Arts Education

Kit Grauer's contribution to teaching in the Faculty of Education has been outstanding. As an instructor of teachers, she is a model of excellence. As the coordinator for the Principles of Teaching course, a required course for all our Teacher Education students, she has played a pivotal role in providing students in their pre-service year with a solid pedagogical foundation. Students, colleagues and the professional community at large share our view of Kit Grauer as an outstanding teacher. She was named the BC Art Educator of the Year for 1993 by the BC Art Teachers Association.

Faculty of Forestry

Tom Sullivan Associate Professor, Department of Forest Sciences

Tom Sullivan's teaching is well prepared and well organized, with a good balance of conceptual and quantitative material, a strong linkage between theory and practical implications and enviable clarity. An individual lecture commonly builds on a theme, developed with concrete examples to illustrate concepts, major points and nuances. His use of visual aids and his timing are excellent. Lectures are characterized by active, rather than passive learning, with a high level of student involvement in discussion.

Faculty of Graduate Studies

Brian Elliott Professor, Department of Anthropology and Sociology

Brian Elliott has been recommended for his excellent role as a high-quality graduate supervisor within Anthropology and Sociology. Many of his students praise him. They state that he consistently demonstrates great openness, sensitivity, patience and respect for them. He stimulates and nurtures his students to reach high standards. He is recognized for developing a collegial atmosphere for all. His students admire his intellectual breadth and his willingness to supervise a large group of students in diverse areas. Faculty of Law

Bruce D. Woolley Visiting Assistant Professor

Bruce Woolley received an LL.B. from UBC in 1978. Following a decade in practice, Bruce began teaching in the Faculty of Law on a part-time basis, dividing his time between the Faculty and the practice of law. Specializing in the law governing real property and real estate transactions, Bruce is a perennial favourite among the many students he loves to teach. His selection as this year's recipient of the 1994 Teaching Prize is a popular choice among law students.

Faculty of Medicine

Alexander Cairns Associate Professor, Division of Endocrinology, Department of Medicine

Sandy Cairns has exemplified the best in clinical teaching during a career spanning 30 years. Dr. Cairns was a graduate of one of the early classes of the UBC Faculty of Medicine in 1956 and the winner of the Hamber Gold Medal for highest standing in the four years of medical school. During his teaching career he has consistently placed in the top echelon of clinical instructors at both the undergraduate and postgraduate level. Dr. Cairns has been an innovative and provocative participant at our Grand Rounds and a role model for countless students. With his unassuming attitude he instills in his students a deep respect for patients and their medical problems. Dr. Cairns is an example to us all of extraordinary dedication to the teaching profession.

David F. Hardwick Professor and Associate Dean, Research and Planning
Department of Pathology

David Hardwick has been rated consistently among the top professors in the Pathology program in Medicine over the past many years. He has also been Director of the Pathology course in the Faculty of Medicine for nearly three decades, a course recently identified by students "as the best taught course in the four years and recommend that it be a model for all others." In addition to being the Medical Undergraduate elected Faculty Advisor for over two decades, Professor Hardwick is currently President of the International Academy of Pathology, the pre-eminent agency for continuing education in pathology worldwide.

William E. Schreiber Associate Professor, Department of Pathology and Laboratory Medicine

William Schreiber is well known for a teaching style that combines exceptional clarity and organization with a large dose of humour. He has developed courses in clinical biochemistry for medical students and pathology residents and has publicized these educational activities in professional journals and at national meetings. Highly rated by students and peers alike, he is a three-time recipient of the medical undergraduate society teaching excellence award, twice from the second year class and once from the third year class. He is currently a member of the strategic planning committee, which will define a new undergraduate curriculum for the UBC Faculty of Medicine.

Faculty of Pharmaceutical Sciences

Frank S. Abbott

Professor and Chair of the Division of Pharmaceutical Chemistry

Frank Abbott's major teaching responsibilities over the years have been as Professor-in-charge of Phar 320, the required organic medicinal chemistry course and as Professor-in-charge of Phar 500, the graduate course in advanced pharmaceutical research techniques. His teaching skills have been consistently recognized by the undergraduate students. He was the first recipient of the Pharmaceutical Sciences Master Teacher Award in 1977, an award given by the graduating class for outstanding contributions by a teacher to the class. Dr. Abbott also received this award in 1983 and again in 1989. Frank Abbott has been a committed and long-standing member of the Faculty Curriculum Committee. He has provided invaluable advice, feedback and guidance to this committee for more than 25 years. Dr. Abbott has always established and maintained an excellent rapport with his classes and is greatly appreciated by the students for his fairness, humour, approachability and for the high standards of instruction in his classes.

Faculty of Science

Murray W. Goldberg

Instructor, Department of Computer Science

Murray Goldberg has taught a wide range of courses in the Department of Computer Science and in each case he received the highest teaching evaluation in the Department. Dr. Goldberg is an exceptional teacher; indeed, most of his students say he is the best teacher they have ever had. He discusses difficult lecture material in a clear and thought-provoking manner using an energetic lecture style and, at the same time, creates a relaxed classroom atmosphere that encourages students to participate in class discussion. His obvious enthusiasm for teaching, his care for students and his ability to motivate and involve them in learning make Dr. Goldberg one of the best teachers in the Faculty of Science.

Paul L. Smith

Professor, Department of Geological Sciences

A specialist in Jurassic ammonoids, Paul Smith is responsible for all paleontology courses in the Department of Geological Sciences. Dr. Smith's commitment to science education extends beyond the Department and the University; he plays an active and enthusiastic role in bringing geology to schools throughout the province.
