## ACADEMIC REGALIA

The wearing of academic costume is a tradition that has persisted from the Middle Ages, when the first Universities were founded.

The regalia vary slightly from one University to another and, within a University, according to the status of the wearer.

At The University of British Columbia the undergraduate's gown is black and of the ordinary stuff material; the yoke is edged with khaki cord. The Master's gown is similar but lacks the cord.

The colours for the degrees are:

The Bachelor's hood is edged with the distinctive colour. The Master's hood is the same as the Bachelor's, except that it is lined with the distinctive colour. The hood for the M.Sc. (Bus. Admin.) is similar to that of the M.Sc., with grey trim and black and white cord. The hood for the M.Eng. is the same as that of the M.A.Sc., except that it is trimmed with a cord of University blue.

The regalia of the Ph.D. consists of a gown, Cambridge style, of maroon silk with front facing-panel and sleeves of University blue with gold piping; a hood, Cambridge pattern, of blue silk outside and gold lining; a cap, decanal bonnet, of maroon silk with gold cord and tassel. The Ed.D. regalia consists of a gown, Cambridge style, of black stuff; a hood, American style, with lining of light blue and with chevron of University blue, white and gold; a cap, decanal bonnet, of black stuff with gold cord and tassel. The D.M.A. regalia is similar to that of the Ed.D. with hood lined with alizarin crimson and a chevron of University blue and gold. The Pharm.D. regalia consists of a gown, Cambridge style, of black stuff with front facing panel and sleeves of dark olive green with gold piping; a hood, American style, with lining of University blue and withchevron of University blue and gold; a cap; decanal bonnet, of black stuff with gold cord and tassel.

The hood for the honorary degree LL.D. is of scarlet broadcloth lined in dark blue velvet; for the D.Sc., it is lined in dark purple and for the D. Litt., it is lined in cream.

## 1995 UNIVERSITY TEACHING PRIZE WINNERS

### Faculty of Agricultural Sciences

Clare Daem Senior Instructor, School of Family and Nutritional Sciences

Clare Daem is recognized by her students as an excellent instructor and her lectures are among the best attended in the School of Family and Nutritional Sciences. She is thorough and up-to-date, presents information in a clear and interesting manner, involves her students actively in class discussions, and encourages them to become critical thinkers. One of her strengths is the congruence between lectures and laboratories, demonstrating clearly to students the link between theory and its practical applications. Laboratory assignments often vary in difficulty in order to challenge good students or to put less-confident students at ease. This requires considerable organization and advance preparation and Clare excels at this organization. She establishes good rapport with her students, and her effort and her enthusiasm for teaching are readily apparent to and appreciated by her students. Letters of support and informal feedback from alumni attest to the long-term value of Clare's teaching, and many of them still have and refer to the extensive reference materials that she prepares and updates each year. Through both her actions and her attitudes, Clare Daem demonstrates an abiding interest in the welfare of her students. As Senior Advisor in the School, she maintains an open-door policy, knows most students personally, and takes an interest in their individual programs and their progress. She often goes to extraordinary lengths to help individual students solve registration problems and meet their program requirements. This concern is not limited to the School's students as she willingly and ably assists students from other departments and faculties who need information and assistance. The idea of master teacher awards most certainly was conceived with teachers like Clare Daem in mind.

### Faculty of Applied Science

Sheldon Green Associate Professor, Department of Mechanical Engineering

Quality and innovation have characterized Professor Green's teaching from the inception of his career at the University of British Columbia. Colleagues in the Department of Mechanical Engineering have acknowledged Professor Green as a dedicated and persuasive teacher, as well as, an excellent academician. Students' comments indicate their appreciation for the time and energy Dr. Green has devoted not only to their classes and labs, but also to their social events and inter-university competitions. They have described him as "going above and beyond the call of duty". His clarity, his interest, his confidence and his passion for teaching provide only some of the reasons for Dr. Green's recognition as one of the 1995 Applied Science Teaching Prize recipients.

Carol Jillings Associate Professor, School of Nursing

Intelligent, humane and liberating teaching have established Professor Jilling's reputation as a nurse educator. Her colleagues at the school of Nursing have characterized Dr. Jilling as an innovator, a scholar and a leader in her profession. Students have described Professor Jillings as "teaching with her soul as well as her mind". She pushes them to achieve their maximum potential while creating a safe and harmonious learning environment. Students have consistently singled her out as a model of professional excellence and a mentor. Dr. Jilling's enthusiasm, ability to respond to the personal and professional needs of students and her creativity make her a worthy recipient of one of the 1995 Applied Science Teaching Prizes.

### Faculty of Arts

Kenneth Bryant Associate Professor, Department of Asian Studies

A stalwart in the faculty's Arts One program for many years, Dr. Kenneth Bryant introduced non-Western continent to its curriculum with great success. In his own department he teaches a wide range of languages and culture courses. His Hindi students noted that his own handouts were better than assigned texts and suggested he write one. He also teaches Urdu poetry. Adjusting the curriculum to the gender makeup and ethnic background of the class, he added work by feminist Pakistani poets of the 1980s to emphasize the

radical shift of agenda and rhetoric from the patriarchal world of Urdu court poetry. He also used made-for-Indian-TV video series and experimented with students composing Urdu poetry and presenting it. Dr. Bryant teaches a first-year literature section in the Department of English with extraordinary dedication and versatility; he also introduces students to work in translation from the Indian literary tradition in addition to standard course list. His student evaluation scores are at the top of the range in all his courses. Written responses are uniformly favorable. Course material is logical and clear. Students remark upon his patience, humour, approachability and enthusiasm.

Julia Cruikshank Associate Professor, Department of Anthropology and Sociology

Dr. Julia Cruikshank is well-known for her innovative teaching in co-operation with the First Nations People of the Yukon and British Columbia. Her innovations include creating, with a colleague, an ethnographic field school with the Sto:lo nation, a time consuming undertaking linking the university's activities more effectively with the wider community. She skillfully introduces students of both native and non-native ancestry to First Nations heritage and the problems of our age. She not only finds ways to encourage students' intellectual development, but through her own example and through deliberate discussion of ethical issues in anthropological research provides the best kind of "moral education". Students find her an inspiration and note she has helped change their self-perceptions and aspirations in the most positive ways. Her students find her teaching intellectually challenging and enlightening and appreciate the way she uses her own research experience to illuminate her arguments. She possesses great skill in encouraging questions, comments and discussion. She also uses student contributions to amplify and clarify points in her lectures.

William French Assistant Professor, Department of History

Dr. William French is a specialist in Mexican history with broad interests in the history of modern Latin American politics and society. He has taught widely at all levels of the department's program, including courses on colonialism in the Americas, modernization in comparative perspective, and a general introduction to Latin American history; senior courses in Latin America social history (three of which he introduced); an honours course on Latin America; and graduate courses in Latin American and comparative history. His deep commitment to comparative inquiry lies at the heart of his teaching. He encourages students to explore relationships between Latin American history and the histories of other communities taught by the department. To the classroom he brings an infectious commitment to his subject, a warm and engaging manner and a deep concern for students. On evaluation questionnaires his students have consistently rated both his teaching and course quality excellent or very good. They find him innovative, enthusiastic, respectful and accessible. His mentoring qualities are noted and the time spent providing extensive constructive criticism on essays and carefully organized discussion to draw out students much appreciated. Needless to say, he teaches to overflowing classes.

J. Kieran Kealy Assistant Professor, Department of English

Dr. J. Kieran Kealy, a member of the Department of English for more than a quarter century, has established a reputation among students such that, as one has observed, it is "increasingly difficult to get into his courses." Another notes "that his class had as many again on the waiting list as could be enrolled." At the third and fourth year level his two main special areas are Children's Literature and Chaucer. He teaches first-year English literature as well. Outstanding as a lecturer, he is informative and entertaining and never dull. He is exceptionally generous with his time, arranging small discussion groups outside formal class hours. Finally he is respectful of others, never patronizing, and offers students positive feedback. Former students now themselves in academe have expressed their indebtedness to him as a role model in developing their own teaching skills. He has been much involved in the department's distinguished honours program for many years. He has for fifteen years operated a book sale, the entire proceeds from which go to the departmental student scholarship fund.

Steven Taubeneck Assistant Professor, Department of Germanic Studies

Dr. Steven Taubeneck, in his third year at UBC, has quickly established an enviable teaching record. His interests in literary theory in general and interdisciplinary and cultural theory in particular have allowed

him to be a major contributor to the Comparative Literature program in graduate studies in the faculty. In addition, his skills are used in Germanic Studies, his own department, to teach language classes at all levels. This term he is also teaching a first-year section in English literature using not only masterpieces in the language but also in translation from German. An interdisciplinarian by training, he is genuinely interdisciplinary in his methods, introducing film, philosophy, history, critical theory and cultural studies to his classes. Students praise his erudition, his careful preparation, his skillful presentation of materials, his helpfulness and availability outside of class hours, and his ability to develop their critical thinking faculties. His popularity with graduate students has led to his serving on numerous dissertation committees.

### Faculty of Dentistry

Rosamund Harrison Assistant Professor, Department of Clinical Dental Science

Dr. Harrison is being recognized as an outstanding teacher by the Faculty in her specialty area of Children's Dentistry. Dr. Harrison has introduced innovative formats in the classroom in order to provide opportunities for students to interactively guide the presentation of material in a manner that reflects their pathway of discovery - learning. In conjunction with colleagues and as the current Division Head, she has redesigned entire courses in paediatric Dentistry and developed criteria-referenced evaluation systems in which the students are trained to provide self-evaluation as a means to develop their professional sense of quality assurance for patient care. She developed a system of continuous feedback of clinical performance to students to assist in their formative evaluation and instituted student-initiated competency-based tests for objective and meaningful summative evaluations. Dr. Harrison is to be commended for her development of effective evaluation in terms of strengthening student learning and her insights in applying these techniques to generate a critical sense of clinical excellence in new professional practitioners.

Joanne Walton Assistant Professor, Department of Clinical Dental Science

Dr. Walton is being recognized as an outstanding teacher by the Faculty in her specialty area of Prosthodontics. She has been tireless in fulfilling her very intensive schedule of weekly lectures, seminars and supervision of patient treatment by students. She has generously worked long after hours to provide consultation with students whose enthusiasm to ensure optimal patient treatment are subsequently encouraged. Lectures have taken on a format in which students can flesh out the content with their own questions and discussion. She has developed a series of brief but focused quizzes to guide student learning. Video technology has been introduced in her sessions to capture the three dimensional aspect of clinical procedures. The calibration of instructors has been a challenging but successful achievement to ensure that each student receives meaningful and accurate feedback. Finally, every opportunity has been taken by Dr. Walton to develop a problem-based approach with each clinical situation in order to develop those skills essential for a comprehensive approach to patients and essential for continued learning throughout a lifetime of new professional challenges.

### Faculty of Commerce and Business Administration

Derek Atkins Professor, Management Science Division

Professor Derek Atkins is the 1994-95 recipient of the Faculty of Commerce CGA Master Teacher Award for his superb "in-class" performance, evidenced by the consistently high student evaluations he receives, but also for his outstanding performance as a Ph.D. and M.Sc. supervisor and as an innovative course developer. Professor Atkins has designed and taught courses in production, operations management and applications of management science. He changed the foci of his courses from their traditional narrow technical content to a broader, more pragmatic context. His efforts have made these important courses more accessible and attractive.

David McPhillips Professor, Industrial Relations Management Division

Professor David McPhillips is the recipient of the 1994-5 Faculty of Commerce Arne Olsen Master Teacher Award for a career of consistently superior creation of a classroom environment where independent thought

is not only encouraged, but expected. David McPhillips' relationship with students extends beyond the classroom. He is always willing to provide advice to students in his office - about school, life after graduation and a myriad of other topics of concern and interest. He constantly stays current on recent developments, using practically-based sources and examples. He motivates students to think for themselves.

### The Faculty of Education

Carl Leggo Assistant Professor, Department of Language Education

Dr. Leggo is an outstanding teacher, role model and mentor. Only superlatives can describe his teaching ability. He is universally admired by teacher education and graduate students and his colleagues for his ability to inspire, encourage creativity and integrate teaching and writing. His work in methods, communications, writing and language across the curriculum courses, as supervisor of practicum students, and as graduate advisor, receives equally laudatory comments. Dr. Leggo lives his life as a poet and writer, bringing to his teaching personal example and experience. He is an inspiration to us all.

Kjell Rubenson Professor, Department of Educational Studies and Director, Centre for Policy Studies in Education

Dr. Rubenson's teaching abilities are exemplary. Departmental colleagues and students past and present attest to his abilities as a teacher, counselor, supervisor, mentor, innovator and guide. He is committed to enriching students' perceptions of and approaches to social and educational inquiry. He provides a wealth of learning opportunities for students that both challenge their perceptions about research and encourage them to a more critical appreciation of different methodologies and paradigms. His work in policy studies is recognized both here at home and internationally and this broad perspective informs his teaching practice to the benefit of colleagues and students.

### Faculty of Forestry

G. Glen Young Associate Professor, Forest Resources Management

Since joining the Faculty in 1969, Glen Young's commitment to his students has been exceptional. Professor Young's approach to teaching is one of guided learning rather than traditional lecture style. His highly effective teaching methods have won great support from the students who benefit from learning the tools necessary to solve problems as well as the underlying theory of the subject. Professor Young has served six years as Counselor for students in the Forest Operations Program, and has been Chairperson of the Faculty Curriculum Committee for the past two years. A letter of support from his students states "We have much respect for the way Glen treats his associates and students and his dedication to the Faculty, the Operations Program and his quality of teaching." Professor Young is a very worthy winner of the Faculty of Forestry Teaching Prize.

### Faculty of Graduate Studies

A.H.J. Dorsey Professor, School of Community and Regional Planning

This year's winner of the Faculty of Graduate Studies Teaching Prize is Professor Tony Dorsey. Professor Dorsey is cross-appointed in the School of Community and Regional Planning and the Westwater Research Centre. Professor Dorsey consistently ranks highly in course evaluations from students in the School of Community and Regional Planning, receiving particular praise for his obvious dedication to teaching, his careful preparation, his prompt and thorough feedback on assignments and the demanding standards he imposes on both his students and himself. He is also a popular supervisor for graduate theses and projects within several Faculty of Graduate Studies units. Students benefit not only from regular one-on-one attention, but also from regular group meetings and social occasions which he organizes on- and off-campus. While this places exceptional demands on him, students benefit immensely from both the individual and group attention.

## Faculty of Law

Joseph C. Smith

Professor, Faculty of Law

J.C. Smith has had a long, distinguished association with the University. A holder of two U.B.C. degrees, he was first appointed to a teaching position in the Faculty of Law in 1961. After 34 years of continuously outstanding teaching and scholarship, J.C. is compelled to retire on June 30 this year, three days after his 65th birthday. Continuing intellectual curiosity, sustained enthusiasm and the ability to challenge and stimulate students have been consistent features of his teaching career. In these circumstances, it is particularly fitting that J.C. has been selected as the prize winner in this, his retirement year. J.C. may be forced formally to retire this year. But he is too active to leave just yet. He will continue to direct a major research and development project in the area of artificial intelligence, an undertaking with the potential to make a substantial contribution to scholarship and the practice of law. In addition, he has generously offered to do some teaching on a volunteer basis. So, happily, law students and the University will have the benefit of this singular person for a little longer. Good luck in your next phase, J.C.!

## Faculty of Medicine

John Gilbert

Professor, School of Audiology and Speech Sciences

Dr. John Gilbert began teaching at UBC over 25 years ago. He founded the graduate program in Audiology and Speech Science, and since its inception, the design of the curriculum has been shaped by his philosophy of teaching and professionalism. Dr. Gilbert served as the Director of the Division (now School) of Audiology and Speech Sciences from 1969 to 1989. He has led the School into a new era of state-of-the-art teaching establishing a new computerized teaching laboratory this year. In 1970, Dr. Gilbert wrote "It would seem to me that in our aim to develop thinking, reasonable, concerned graduates that we must employ in our teaching some aspect with some facet that should be called wisdom. We have to demonstrate that, particularly in the area which is concerned with human beings, what we teach and what we learn is for the concern of human beings. . . somehow we have to give our students in their training such ideals." Dr. Gilbert has done so and we have no doubt that he deserves this recognition for his excellence in teaching.

Ray Baker

Assistant Professor, Department of Family Practice

Dr. Ray Baker has had a background as a family doctor in the small B.C. mining town of Logan Lake. In 1986 he received certification through the American Society of Addiction Medicine by means of experience and examination. Dr. Baker has served as medical advisor to the provincial government's alcohol and drug programs and he has been instrumental in establishing the AMIR (Addiction Medicine and Intercollegial Responsibility) Program in the medical school curriculum. He has championed AMIR across departments, intrepidly challenging the conventions of course titles and hours. Dr. Baker has educational vision. He sees the learning potential in individuals and situations and capitalizes on it. He is flexible in method, yet at the same time, guided by clear objectives. Dr. Baker is not bound by historical precedent, but uses his own experience as teacher and learner and the experience of others as a basis for innovative problem solving. Dr. Baker is highly deserving of the Award for Excellence in Teaching for his tireless dedication as a clinical teacher.

Alexander (Dooley) Goumeniouk

Clinical Assistant Professor, Department of Pharmacology and Therapeutics

Dr. Dooley Goumeniouk was a graduate of the Medical Class of 1987 at UBC. In 1989 he commenced his teaching activities and since that time his teaching ability has become legendary among the medical students, to the point that he has been known to receive a standing ovation from the students before he even begins the lecture. He has made a tremendous impact on the students - not only because of the clarity, eloquence and disarming humour of his presentations, but also because of his obvious caring for the students and his sensitivity, particularly in dealing with students' questions and answers to issues he poses in class. Dr. Goumeniouk has received the Award for Teaching Excellence from the second year medical students for two consecutive years, 1992 and 1993. In his brief teaching career he has established a solid reputation as a talented, conscientious and passionately committed teacher.

## Faculty of Pharmaceutical Sciences

Marion Pearson

Instructor, Pharmaceutical Sciences

Ms. Pearson is an Instructor in the Faculty with responsibilities in 1st and 2nd year Professional Practice courses. She was the recipient of the Bristol Myers-Squibb Teaching Excellence Award in 1992 and since 1993 has been a Facilitator for the Instructional Skills Workshops coordinated by the Centre for Faculty Development. Ms. Pearson has focused much of her creative energies on developing different and innovative teaching methodologies in the classroom to promote more active learning by the students. She has made many contributions to curriculum and course development in the Faculty. Overall, Ms. Pearson is an outstanding teacher who develops an excellent rapport with her students and who is willing to share her expertise with other instructors to improve their teaching.
